Since the RAK Colleges Learning Centres had been inactive in 2012-2013, marketing our services this year became a top priority. The ILC staff made scheduled visits to all classes at the beginning of the semester to promote our services and a "Meet and Greet" was organized for faculty and staff. The ILC also increased its presence through social media, Twitter and Instagram. As of May 2014, the ILC had approximately 700 followers in Instragram. A website with RAK ILC logo was also created. A major initiative this year has been the promotion of Clarity programs. Introductory PD's in Clarity programs were offered to both staff and faculty. Clarity use has shown a marked increase in this academic year and IELTS grades in December 2013 at RKMC were the highest recorded ever.

Another initiative this academic year was our promotion of QR codes which are increasingly being used in education. QR Code week's activities included workshops for students and staff on the use of QR Codes in today's mobile world, raffles, games, and surprises. QR codes with links to resources were placed around the Library and ILC. There was also a PD for faculty on uses of QR Codes in the classroom that included a treasure hunt.

Math, Debate, Spanish, Japanese and Korean clubs were run by volunteer faculty members. Students met once a week and at the end of the semester, all participants were awarded a certificate.

Brain Booster and I Genius workshops were offered by the ILC throughout the semester. Topics included soft skills such as Self-Exploration and Study Skills and training in iPad Apps such as Explain Everything, iMovie, Pic Collage.





Learning Technologies

- A major initiative this year has been the promotion of Clarity programs. Seven Foundation groups were booked weekly in the RKMC ILC Classroom for work with the Clarity program, Active Reading. Road to IELTS was promoted among Level 4 Foundation students. Introductory PD's in Clarity programs were also offered to both staff and faculty. Clarity use has shown a marked increase in this academic year and IELTS grades in December 2013 at RKMC were the highest recorded ever.
- A repository of self-access materials are available on Learning Centre Website and SharePoint for all students
- Workshops were given at both colleges in iPad Apps iMovie, Explain Everything, Updating iOS system were given to faculty and students.
- Coordinator visited classrooms assisted by ED Tech technicians to assist in iPad basics like setting up an Apple ID, getting mail.
- The first week of semester was QR Code Week which included activities and PDs in the use of QR codes in today's mobile world and education.
- Workshops for faculty and students were given to faculty and students on 'How to Use Clarity 'and on 'Grammarly'.



Curriculum Support & Collaboration


- ILCs work closely with Chairs of Foundation programs to insure that materials used support the curriculum and learning objectives of Foundation students.
